#### Proposed By-Law Amendments for September 2018 Vote

#### By-Law Change 1 - (Recommended for approval by the Board of Directors)

#### **Article V: Membership Regulations**

Section 1: Any man may apply for adult membership in accordance with the established procedures of the organization if the following qualifications are met: Change THEY to HE in each statement to read

- A. He has reached to age of twenty-one (21) years, and
- B. He was born of an Italian parent, or a parent of Italian lineage, or
- C. He was adopted by an Italian parent, or parent of Italian lineage, or
- D. He is the spouse of a person who is Italian, or of Italian lineage, or
- E. He is the spouse of a person adopted by a person of Italian lineage, or
- F. ADD He submits the results of genetic testing that show Italian ancestry

#### By-Law Change 2 (Recommend for approval by the Board of Directors)

#### Article VI: Section 9: President

The President is the highest-ranking member of the lodge. As the leader of the lodge, his duties are to:

B. See that the laws of the Lodge are observed and that *ADD the By-laws* and the deliberations of the Board and the General Membership are carried out.

#### Article VI: Section 11: Parliamentarian (Recommended for Approval by the Board of Directors)

The Parliamentarian gives opinions concerning the application and interpretation of the By-laws and rules of the Lodge **DELETE**: and sees that they are observed and properly applied.

ADD: He shall be responsible for compiling and maintaining the most current By-laws of Roma Lodge and the Rules of the Lodge. He will make them available to members upon request.

#### By-Law Change 3 (NOT recommended by the Board of Directors)

Article VI. Section 12

#### **Current By-law**

The Recording Secretary .... duties are:

A. To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership. The minutes of each respective meeting shall be read for approval and corrections at the next successive corresponding meeting (i.e. Board or General Membership).

#### Proposed By-law

Section 12

- A. To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership.
  - The minutes of the Board of Directors shall be read for approval and corrections at the next successive Board of Directors meeting.
  - ii) The minutes of the General Membership Meeting will be available to the Membership at the next successive Membership meeting and approved upon a motion requested by the President, but Minutes will read only upon a motion made by a member and passed by the membership in attendance.

#### By-Law Change 4

#### Article V: Membership Regulations (NOT recommended for approval by the Board of Directors)

Section 17: In the event an officer or director is absent from three (3) Board meetings **ADD** *or Membership Meetings* between March 1<sup>st</sup> and February 28<sup>th</sup> of the next calendar year, the Board must decide whether that officer or director should be removed from office.

#### By-Law Change 5 (Recommended for approval by the Board of Directors)

#### **Article VI: Organization**

#### Section 9: Board Committees

The President is the highest-ranking officer of the lodge. As the leader of the Lodge, his duties are to:

E. Subject to majority approval of the Board, appoint the members of the Board as chairmen of the Lodge Standing Committees:

Food Services

Membership

Planning and By-laws and Rules

Scholarship

Social

as well as chairmen of all committees of the Lodge (unless the laws of the Lodge provide otherwise). He shall be an ex-officio member of all such committees, except the Nominations and Elections Committee. (Amended December 4, 2009)
