

# A Racine tradition Roma Lodge to take over Pancake Day

RACINE — After 64 years under the direction of the Kiwanis Club of Greater Racine, Roma Lodge will be taking over Racine's annual Pancake Day next year.

The Kiwanis chapter, which decided in September to disband at the end of this calendar year, voted on Wednesday to pass direction of Pancake Day to Roma Lodge, which has vowed to continue the event at Festival Hall on the first Saturday in May.

"We're honored that they chose us," said David Chiapete, president of Roma Lodge.

The Kiwanis Club of West Racine, which declined to take over direction of the event itself, has agreed to support Roma Lodge in the endeavor.

Originally, some 14 organizations expressed interest in hosting Pancake Day, but by the time the vote was taken, the list had been whittled down to five.

"They were all worthy organizations," said Randy Savaglio, president of the Kiwanis Club of Greater Racine. "It was hard to pick."

The Kiwanis who have been running the event plan to lend their expertise to the Roma Lodge during the first year. Chiapete said the Roma Lodge looks forward to working with the Kiwanis Club of West Racine on this event and said it will continue to be called Kiwanis Club Pancake Day, with sponsorship by Roma Lodge.

Roma Lodge has donated more than \$400,000 to various causes over the past 25 years or so, Chiapete said, and will continue to donate some of the proceeds of Pancake Day. He said it was too early to say which local organizations or charities would benefit.

He said members of Roma Lodge take great pride in doing things for the community.

"It's a tremendous community event," Chiapete said of Pancake Day.

### The vote

Savaglio said he didn't want to speak for the other members who voted as to why they chose Roma Lodge. He said the transition was at the very beginning stages.

The Kiwanis Club of Greater Racine is one of three local Kiwanis clubs. An aging membership was a factor in the decision to disband, along with a lack of younger members joining, board member Jerry Andersen previously told The Journal Times.

Roma Lodge was founded in the early 1900s as a mutual aid society. The Roma Lodge continues as a fraternal organization that fosters Italian-American culture through social, cultural, and entertainment events, scholarships, and gifts to local charities. The lodge also operates a banquet and conference center at 7130 Spring St., Mount Pleasant.

# We are bringing tournament cribbage to the Roma Lodge.



## Saturday 26 January 2019 in the Members lounge Start time is 12 noon.

Event will run through 2PM. Registration is from 11AM to 11:45. Orientation from 11:45 to noon

Format: 6 games against 6 different individual opponents

**Cost: \$10 per person.** \$1 of that sum will go to a drawing to be held at noon. You are also entitled to a drink up to \$3.00 The remaining entry fee is paid out to the high score cards. In addition there will be two optional side pools \$5 and \$15

### Some helpful hints to playing

1. A game should be played within 20 minutes

2. Scorecards will be provided. A win is 2 points, a skunk is 3 points and a loss counts 0. Spread points are important and will be recorded. There are no double skunks

3. First deal is determined by cutting of the deck. Low card deals first. Thereafter each time a player is about to deal his opponent will cut the cards after they have been shuffled. A normal shuffle is 3 to 4 times After the hands have been dealt the remaining cards are placed on the dealers side of the board not on top of the board

4. During play all cards remain face up even after a Go has been called5. Mistakenly picking up your front peg to peg a score constitutes that peg

becoming your back peg. 6. Always peg out to hole 121

7. Should any disputes arise or rulings be needed a judge with a rule book will be on hand

The tournament is open to members and their guests. We would appreciate a call or text to Mark Mano 813 523-7052 or Dave Chiapete 262 939-5914 so we have enough boards and playing cards.

This is about having fun and yet enjoying some competition. There are lots of ways to play cribbage and that is why we are using the format indicated. It will help to ensure that happens,
