### ROMA LODGE MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

### What is the Scholarship?

Each year Roma Lodge makes scholarships available to children of its members. There is a \$4,000 scholarship, payable in \$1000 increments at the beginning of each of four academic years. In addition, the Lodge awards a maximum of three one-time \$500 scholarships to the second, third, and fourth place rated scholarship applicants. The scholarships can be applied to any full time course of study leading to a recognized baccalaureate degree at any accredited United States college or university of the recipient's choice.

All graduating high school seniors, who are biological or adopted children of Roma Lodge members, are eligible to apply for the scholarship. An applicant's father must be a member in good standing as of January 31<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year that application for the scholarship is made. A scholarship recipient's father must continue to be a member in good standing for the duration of the scholarship. Candidates must be planning to pursue a full-time program of study (12 credits or more) in a college or university in the United States. Recipients of the Roma Lodge Merit Scholarships will not receive any other scholarships offered through Roma Lodge.

### **Application Requirements**

The applicants must:

- Complete a high school college preparatory course of study
- Demonstrate a commendable academic record which will qualify for admission to the college or university of their choice.
- Demonstrate positive citizenship and leadership qualities through participation in school and community activities.
- Show potential for higher academic success by achieving ACT or SAT scores acceptable to the college or university of their choice.
- Submit an official high school transcript
- Submit an ACT or SAT scores report form
- Submit two letters of recommendation

Financial need will not be considered during the selection process.

### THE RUSSELL AND HELEN MISSURELI SCHOLARSHIP

<u>What is the Scholarship</u>: The Russell and Helen Missureli Scholarship was created to recognize their service, over many years, to Roma Lodge, the church, and the community at large. Scholarship funds were donated by the family and friends of the Missurelis on the occasion of Russell 's ninetieth birthday. The scholarship awards \$1000 to a child of a Roma Lodge member.

<u>Who is Eligible?</u>: All graduating high school seniors, who are biological or adopted children of Roma Lodge members, are eligible to apply for the scholarship. An applicant's father must be a member in good standing as of January 31<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year that application for the scholarship is made. A scholarship recipient's father must continue to be a member in good standing for the duration of the scholarship. Applicants must be planning to pursue a full or part-time program in an associate degree or baccalaureate degree program at any accredited college or university in the United States. Recipients of the Missureli Scholarship will not receive any other scholarships offered through Roma Lodge.

Application Requirements: Applicants must demonstrate:

- Acceptance as a student in an associate degree or baccalaureate degree program.
- An exemplary record of community service as evidenced by a list of community, school, or church related activities.
- Academic achievement as evidenced by a full transcript of grades.
- Good character as evidenced by two letters of recommendation

Financial need <u>will not</u> be considered during the selection process.




