



Player Spotlight:

A Bocce Journey from Roma to the National Circuit

Many Roma Lodge members know David Silvani through his years of involvement with Kids Bocce, league play and tournaments at the Lodge. What some may not realize is that David's passion for the game has carried him well beyond our courts and into the national bocce circuit. As he begins this next chapter as a semi-professional player with the Highwood Stallions, David was asked to share his bocce journey in his own words. From learning the game alongside family and Roma mentors, to competing across the country and helping grow the next generation of players, David reflects on what bocce means to him and how he hopes to continue representing Roma Lodge at a higher level.

Q: When did you begin playing bocce seriously or competitively?

My bocce journey began in 2009, when I learned the game from some of Roma's best players at the time, Zuddy DeRose, Ceasar Bosco and my grandfather Eugene Silvani. After several years of league play, I started competing more seriously and traveling the "bocce circuit" in 2018.

However, my true tournament journey began at home with the Roma Summer and Winter tournaments, along with the Singles Tournament we hosted in 2014 and 2015. The Singles Tournament was my first real taste of what bocce could become for me. Winning the first-place jacket in 2014 solidified my love for the game and playing in the finals the following year against one of the men who helped shape me as a player, Ceasar Bosco, pushed that love even further. It showed me what bocce truly stands for.

Player Spotlight:

A Bocce Journey from Roma to the National Circuit

Q: What do you enjoy most about the game of bocce?

For me, it's the strategy. Bocce is just as mental as it is physical, if not more so. It's an inclusive game, open to all skill levels, making it one of the best sports for teaching focus and teamwork.

As I've traveled across the country and played at different venues, I've found a deep appreciation for learning the unique rules, courts, and cultures associated with bocce in different regions.

Q: Can you share a bit of history about the Roma Boyz team and your involvement with them?

The idea of the Roma Boyz came together around the same time we started traveling the bocce circuit. No matter who was on the team, people would greet us as "the Roma boys." My wife, Bri, began making merchandise and created an Instagram account where we could livestream our games.

What started as simple team apparel evolved into merchandise we sold while traveling and at Roma tournaments. The first official Roma Boyz team was established in 2023 and consisted of Jim Silvani, Joe Buscemi, Joe Cicero, and myself.



Q: Tell us about your new team, the Highwood Stallions, and what joining them means to you.

The Highwood Stallions are the official semi-pro team for the Highwood Bocce Club. We are a well-balanced team of six players, each bringing a unique skill set to the court. Team morale is one of our strongest assets, and our mix of personalities brings excitement, energy, and joy to the game for both players and fans.

Joining the Stallions gives me the opportunity to showcase everything I've learned while challenging myself during this new phase of my bocce career.

Q: Do you follow a specific training or practice routine as you prepare for the upcoming season?

Individually, I continue to play two league nights at Roma and have joined a league night at the Mazzini-Verdi Club. Anytime I have the chance to throw extra balls, I take it. Stallions-specific training will begin in the coming weeks and will include multiple practice days per week, including scrimmages. As our mid-February start date approaches, both team practices and my personal training time will increase.

Q: Kids Bocce continues to grow at Roma Lodge. Can you share some history about the program and your involvement?

When we took over Kids Bocce about seven years ago, the program was much smaller than it is today. We decided to expand it beyond just members' grandchildren and children, opening it to friends, neighbors, and extended family. Kids of almost any age are welcome, as long as they can hold a ball and follow the rules.

I've always viewed Kids Bocce as the future of the lodge. Teaching kids to love the game helps instill valuable life skills such as patience, teamwork, determination, and a connection to Italian culture. These values are shared by the Highwood Stallions as well, who plan to launch a youth league at Highwood Bocce Club called the "Highwood Colts."

Q: Do you have a message for young players interested in getting involved in bocce?

Like any sport, bocce takes time and practice to develop your skills. Strategy and consistency don't come overnight, but as you grow as a player and as a person, you'll find that bocce is a lot like life. There is always something new to learn.

Q: Is there anything you'd like to say to your fellow Roma Lodge members as you take on this new opportunity?

I invite all my fellow members to join me on this journey. I hope you'll follow along as I grow as a semi-pro player and represent Roma Lodge at a higher level.

This professional bocce opportunity is new not only to me, but also to the Roma Lodge. I hope we can make the most of it together. Come see a game, watch online, buy merchandise, post on social media, or simply talk about it. Help spread the word and join me in this exciting new chapter.


