## Proposed By-Law Change

A change is proposed to **ARTICLE VI- ORGANIZATION, Section 12, Subsection-A** of the Roma Lodge By-Laws.

### Background:

The Roma Lodge Board Of Directors realizes the importance of having minutes of prior monthly membership meetings available for the membership to see, read, and approve. This proposed change seeks to eliminate the reading of a prior meeting's minutes. Meeting minutes would be made available prior to a membership meeting in hardcopy and/or digital format. This will allow more time to focus on the current meeting and reports of items and issues that are moving forward in the days and months to come.

**Article VI-ORGANIZATION, Section 12, Subsection A (VI-12-A)** currently reads as follows:

### Section 12:

The Recording secretary is the custodian of the archives and the keeper of the seal of the Lodge. He shall receive a salary as recommended by the Board of Directors. His duties are:

- A. To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership. The minutes of each respective meeting shall be read for approval and corrections at the next successive corresponding meeting (i.e. Board or General Membership).

The *proposed* change to **VI-12-A** is as follows:

- A: To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership. The minutes of each respective meeting shall be **MADE AVAILABLE PRIOR TO THE MEETING** for approval and corrections at the next successive corresponding meeting (i.e. Board or General Membership).

The net change, if approved of by the membership, is that minutes would no longer be read/recapped at monthly membership meetings.

*Per Roma Lodge by-laws, a proposed by-law change must be published in the Lodge newsletter at least thirty (30) days prior to the meeting at which the change will be voted upon. Hence, this matter will be voted upon at the May, 2026 membership meeting.*





The 2026 Kids Bocce season wrapped up with the annual banquet on March 29, bringing players, families and volunteers together to close out another successful year on the courts.



The banquet served as a final opportunity for participants to come together and celebrate the season. We look forward to welcoming everyone back next year for another great run of Kids Bocce.









# Christopher Columbus

## Advocating for Italian American Recognition

To my Roma Lodge brothers: As you may know, there is a small Christopher Columbus monument in downtown Racine, located on a green space just north of Festival Park. There is an accompanying section of road named "Columbus Causeway" under county ownership, leading to the Marina. There was previously a longer section of the same name that went into Racine, but this was changed by the City Council to "Kipikawi," as that section falls under city jurisdiction.

A fellow Racine County board supervisor brought a motion to the county board to rename the remaining section still bearing Columbus' name to "Kipikawi," which was then referred to the public works committee, which I am a member of. On 3/12/2026, the committee had planned to hear arguments and potentially vote to send this item back to the full board for approval.

I am happy to report to you that the motion failed that night, and the Columbus name will remain, at least for the time being. Had this passed, surely the removal of the monument would have followed. That evening, I read a statement which explained the importance of Christopher Columbus to the Italian American community, and many in attendance were surprised by the history surrounding Columbus and Columbus Day. This statement is attached for your review.

I want to thank Vince Ruffolo, David Chiapete and Keith Stannis for writing letters to the County Board expressing opposition to the name change. These were critical in helping the committee understand the importance of the issue, and ultimately, make the right decision.
