## Proposed By-Law Change

(Scheduled to be voted upon at the May, 2026 membership meeting)

A change is proposed to **ARTICLE VI- ORGANIZATION, Section 12, Subsection-A** of the Roma Lodge By-Laws.

### Background:

The Roma Lodge Board Of Directors realizes the importance of having minutes of prior monthly membership meetings available for the membership to see, read, and approve. This proposed change seeks to eliminate the reading of a prior meeting's minutes. Meeting minutes would be made available prior to a membership meeting in hardcopy and/or digital format. This will allow more time to focus on the current meeting and reports of items and issues that are moving forward in the days and months to come.

**Article VI-ORGANIZATION, Section 12, Subsection A (VI-12-A)** currently reads as follows:

### Section 12:

**The Recording secretary is the custodian of the archives and the keeper of the seal of the Lodge. He shall receive a salary as recommended by the Board of Directors. His duties are:**

- A. To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership. The minutes of each respective meeting shall be read for approval and corrections at the next successive corresponding meeting (i.e. Board or General Membership).**

The **proposed** change to **VI-12-A** is as follows:

- A: To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership. The minutes of each respective meeting shall be **MADE AVAILABLE PRIOR TO THE MEETING** for approval and corrections at the next successive corresponding meeting (i.e. Board or General Membership).**

The net change, if approved of by the membership, is that minutes would no longer be read/recapped at monthly membership meetings.

**Per Roma Lodge by-laws, a proposed by-law change must be published in the Lodge newsletter at least thirty (30) days prior to the meeting at which the change will be voted upon. Since this proposed change was published in the April, 2026 edition of the Lodge newsletter, the by-law requirement has been met. Hence, this matter is scheduled to be voted upon at the May, 2026 membership meeting.**

# **Italian Festival 2026**

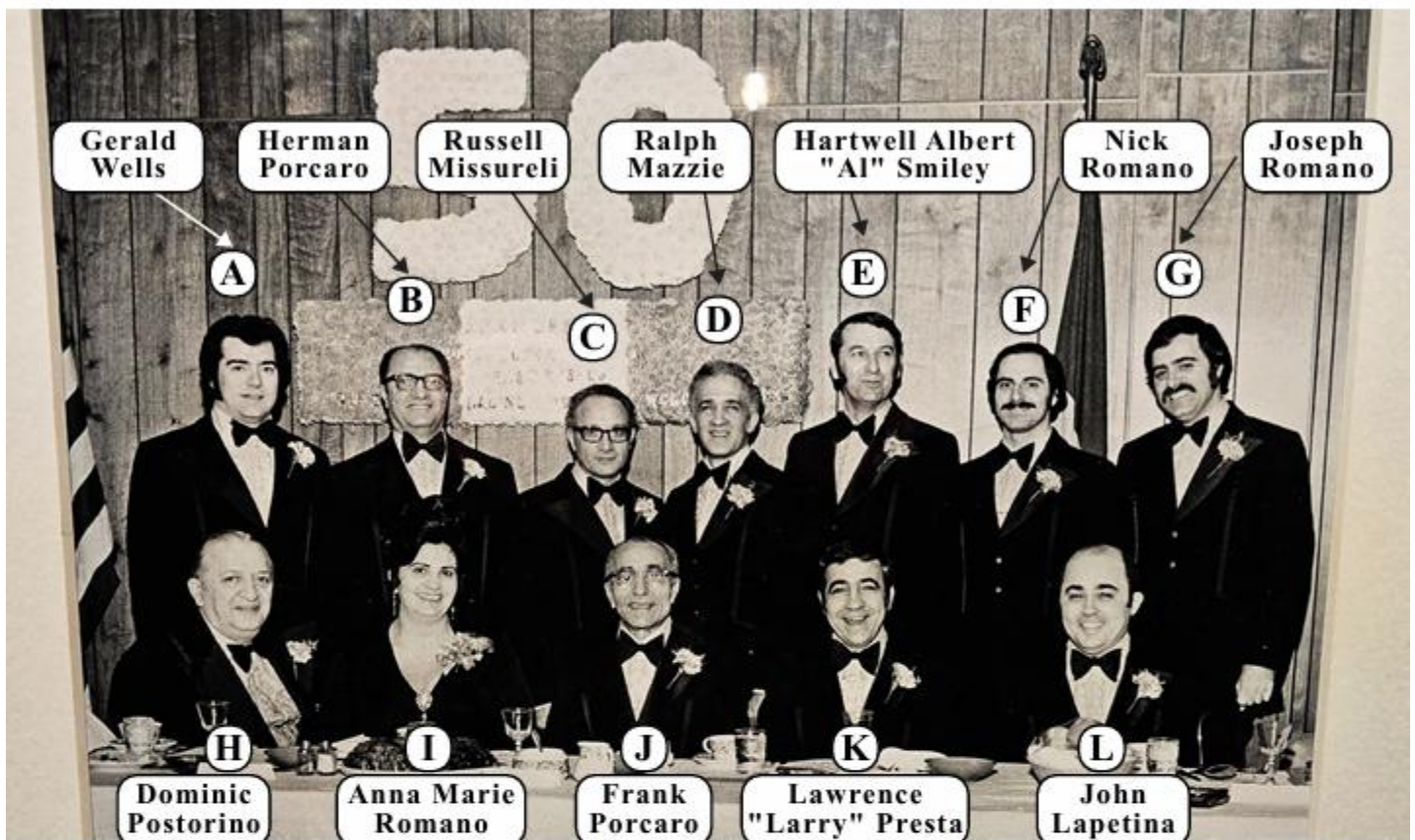
**July 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>**

Thanks to the help of our members, I am happy to share that we have successfully identified every individual in the featured photo.

A special thank you to Nick Romano and an additional anonymous contributor for helping confirm the faces and put names to each individual in the photo. This kind of member involvement is exactly what brings our Hall of History to life.

We were also able to add important context to the moment, including that Anna Marie Romano was serving as President of Vittoria Colonna at the time, and that Russell Missureli was serving as President of Roma Lodge when the photo was taken. Details like this help tell a fuller story and highlight the leadership and involvement that have shaped our Lodge over the years.

It is also believed that this photo was taken in 1973 during Roma Lodge's 50th Anniversary celebration, further adding to the significance of the moment captured.

The photo also includes several past and sitting Roma Lodge Presidents, including Russell Missureli (1961–1964, 1969–1970, 1973–1974, 1977–1978, 1986–1987, 1991–1992), Domenick Postorino (1952) and John Lapetina (1971–1972), highlighting the leadership and involvement represented in this moment.

This is exactly what this effort is about. Taking moments from our past and preserving them with the names, stories and meaning behind them.

With this photo now fully identified, we are moving on to the next.

## On The Pallino (continued)

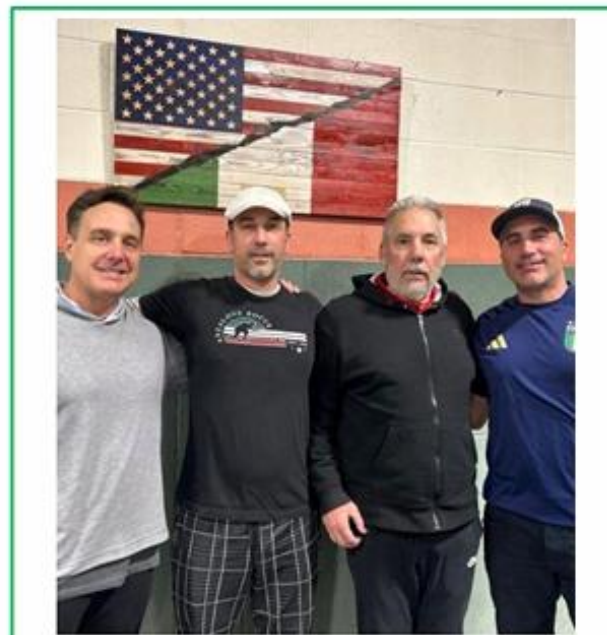
