History of the Beginning of the Vittoria Colonna Lodge #1355

Minutes of a very important meeting held in the year 1925 on the 22nd day of March at 5:30 P.M. at the hall situated at 2117 Mead St. in County of Racine, State of Wisconsin, United States of America.

Joseph Filipone was assisted by his secretary Enrico Lucarelli and the members of Roma Lodge #1196 of the Order Sons of Italy in America proceeded with the ritual of calling the meeting to order.

The Venerable took his seat then orders the officers to take their places, orders the closing of the doors, and asks the secretary to call the roll call of officers. The following officers were present, Mr. Joe Filipone, Anthony Pagliaro, Tony Wells, Castenzio Vallone, Rosario DeMark, Eugenio DeRose, Enrico Lucarelli, Eugenio Aiello, Santo Falcone, Silvio Volpintesta, Rocco Litrenta, Antonio Rizzo, Lorenzo Fumo, Enrico Mazzei, Leonardo Speranza, Giovanni Garbo, Felice Peterro, Eduardo Gioiello, Fiipo Ruffalo, and Leopaldo Puzzo.

The president ascertained that there were enough members to conduct the meeting. Orders the minutes of the previous meeting and they were read and approved.

The president was pleased that all the officers were present and so proceeded with the initiation of the new candidates. The new candidates that were initiated were: Nazareno Arcadipano, Salvatore Donato, Eugenio Silvani, and Gaetano Garrone. Brother Gerome Litrenta acted as herald imparting to them all the rules and regulations of the order of the Roma Lodge. At the completion of the initiation of the new members, preparations were in order to install the officers of the Vittoria Colonna Lodge #1355 to be as a Sister Lodge to the Roma Lodge. Rev. Domenico Raffone, the Supreme Deputy and Antonio Pagliari acted as herald installing the new officers and seating them in their respective places.

The ceremony was impressive and unforgettable. Speeches were from Professor Militelli of Chicago, Dr. LaPiana and Elenora Dusio of Chicago, and Venerable Dante Eligiero of Milwaukee and others also participated in this program. Antionette Greco, Anna Carelli, and Antionetta Rafonne were put in charge of compiling the by-laws for the Vittoria Colonna Lodge.

After the meeting sandwiches, cookies, and ice cream were enjoyed by all. Dancing followed till late, and everybody had a good time and left happy.

Members Story of Joining Roma Lodge – Mark Mano

Back in 1977 I took a job selling Oldsmobiles and Hondas at the Frank Gentile agency. My boss was Augie Stretti. One of my coworkers was Joe Jardina. After I had been working there a while, they asked me to join them at the Roma Lodge after work on a Friday night to play poker. At that time Roma was located on N. Memorial Dr., right next-door to Gallo manufacturing.

I am a gambler at heart, so playing cards fit right into my bag. Three of the players that I met were Gino and Emil Infusino as well as Mike Gallo. I enjoyed those Friday night games and in 1979 Augie and Joe suggested I join the Roma Lodge and I did.

I had stopped working at Gentile and got Mano Fencing going full time. After I joined, I continue to play in those Friday night card games into the 90's when we had moved into our present building. I remember our festivals being held in the parking lot of our building on Memorial Drive.

In 1987 when we opened our present location, we would meet in the card room off the members lounge and play. Often so they could get out of the restaurant earlier, I would go over on a Friday night and help Gino and Emil count the receipts.

Through the 1990s when Zuddy DeRose ran the members lounge the Wednesday night buffet started and we would come over here often. When I moved to Florida full-time in 2000 it was one of the things I truly missed about Racine. I continued to pay my dues to the lodge as well as buy all my raffle tickets required every year.
