

If you are notified of a funeral during your scheduled three-month period, you are expected to attend to represent the Lodge. You are not required to attend every funeral; however, you are encouraged to attend at least one during the quarter. Other members are also encouraged to attend. There will be a special Roma Lodge sign in book at the service for members who attend to verify that they are fulfilling their obligation.

NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS.

At the July members' meeting two proposed amendments to the Roma Lodge By-laws were announced. Those proposed amendments will be discussed at the August general members' meeting and voted on at the September general members' meeting.

The proposed amendments are:

 an amendment to ARTICLE VIII – MEETINGS, Section 1 which currently states:

"Section 1. The regular meeting of the General Membership of the Lodge will be held on the second Friday of the month; except when the second Friday falls on a legal holiday, in which case the meeting will then be held on the following Friday."

The proposed amendment would change Section 1 to the following:

"Section 1. The regular meeting of the General Membership of the Lodge will be held on the first Friday of the month; except when the first Friday falls on a legal holiday, in which case the meeting will then be held on the following Friday."

And

- 2. an amendment to Article V, Section 2, Paragraphs E and F. which currently states:
 - "E. Following recommendation of the Membership Committee and approval by the Board of Directors, the name of the applicant and his sponsor must appear in the monthly newsletter, so that the general membership will have 30 days' notice of the proposed new member prior to a vote on admission, and an opportunity to advise the Membership Chairman if there is reason for disapproval of the applicant.
 - F. The applicant will be voted upon at the next regularly scheduled general membership meeting that the applicant attends so that the applicant is available to be introduced to the membership in attendance."

The proposed amendment would change Paragraphs E. and F. to:

- "E. Following: 1) the Membership Committee's review of the application and any additional materials pertinent to the application; 2) completion of its interview of the applicant, and; 3) delivery of its recommendation to the Board of Directors, the Board of Directors will make a determination as to whether the applicant should be deemed acceptable to become a member of the Lodge. If the Board of Directors determines that the applicant is acceptable for membership, the name of the applicant and his sponsor must appear on the Roma Lodge website under the Membership Section and be published in the monthly newsletter so that the general membership will have notice of the proposed new member. This will also give the membership an opportunity to advise the Membership Chairman if there is reason for disapproval of the applicant prior to a vote on admission of the applicant as a member at the next members' meeting.
- F. If either a member of the Board or the General Membership has questions or concerns regarding the applicant that cannot be resolved in a timely manner, the applicant and his proponent must meet with the Membership Committee to address any issues of concern. In this case, a final decision on the applicant will be postponed until the Board of Directors has determined that any concerns have been resolved to its satisfaction."

(This amendment will shorten the amount of time between when the Board of Directors makes a determination that an applicant should be deemed acceptable to become a member of the Lodge, and when the general membership may take a vote on whether the applicant should become a probational member of the lodge.)

These proposed amendments will be discussed at our upcoming August General Members' Meeting, and the membership present at the September general members' meeting will then vote on whether either, both or none of the proposed amendments will be adopted into the By-laws of the Lodge.





40th Annual Bocce Invitational Tournament Sunday, August 13, 2023

The 40th Annual Roma Lodge Summer Bocce Tournament is scheduled for Sunday, August 13. More information will follow via e-mail and in the next newsletter. Included are the rules and entry form.

Bocce Rules

- 1. Each team will consist of four (4) players plus an alternate if so desired in both the open/men's tournament as well as the women's tournament:
- 2. If the pallino goes out of bounds, it will be placed on the nail. If the large ball goes out of bounds, it is considered a dead ball. The pallino must cross the center line to be in play, a player's ball does not.
- 3. A team must have four (4) players to start a game (2 players on one end and 2 on the other end throw 2 balls each). A team has 10 minutes from the time the ref calls for the game to begin to have an eligible team. Once a player begins a game and is substituted for, he/she may not re-enter the same game. Once a player begins a game on a certain side, he/she must remain on that side the entire game, unless substituted for.
- 4. The referee will handle all games. The Bocce Committee will decide major disputes.

On behalf of the Roma Lodge and its members, we would like to invite you to this year's Roma Lodge Bocce Tournament. We hope that you will be able to participate in this exciting event which not only allows everyone to play the wonderful game of bocce, but also presents a festival atmosphere with all the great people who join us.

Again, this year's tournament will be Round Robin Style. This means that all teams will be playing a minimum of 3 (possibly 4) games. All games will be played up to between 10 and 12 points, depending on the number of entries. Once group play is completed, those teams advancing will play in a single elimination tournament. The finals will all be played up to 16 points.

This year, we will once again have Roma Lodge's famous food, including pane fritta (fried bread dough) made by Lisa Domanico, Joan Domanico, Rosemarie Domanico, and their entire crew of amazing women from the Vittoria Colonna Lodge! Kringle, bombers, tomato salad, corn on the cob, and Roma Lodge's famous buffet dinner featuring Stuffed Shells and our popular Italian baked chicken! Tap beer and soda will be included from 10:30-3:30. Cash prizes will be awarded to at least the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places.

For those of you who come from Illinois and the Milwaukee, Kenosha, and Madison area, we once again look forward to sharing our club with all of you. The great thing about our tournament is that we have been fortunate to have good teams come play, but we also have many teams who just love to play bocce...enjoying the food and camaraderie equally as much.
