NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS

At the July general membership meeting it was announced that the board of directors of Roma Lodge has proposed an amendment to the Roma Lodge By-laws.

It was also announced at the July general membership meeting that the proposed amendment would be published in the August Newsletter, discussed at the August general membership meeting and voted on at the September general membership meeting.

The proposed amendment, if passed, would allow men, who are currently ineligible to join Roma Lodge due to their lack of an Italian lineage, to join the Lodge in a limited fashion.

In essence, the amendment would create a subcategory of membership. Members of the proposed sub-category of membership shall be called Italophilian members and would have the same benefits available to general members of Roma Lodge except the following:

- They shall not be able to vote in elections to determine the Officers and Directors of the lodge.
- They shall not be able to propose amendments to the By-laws of Roma Lodge, or to vote on proposed amendments to the Bylaws of Roma Lodge.
- 3. The Board of Directors of Roma Lodge shall have the power to make all rules pertaining to the duties of such members in respect to dues and duties of Italophilian members.
- 4. The application for membership as an Italophilian member of Roma Lodge shall require the applicant to take an oath wherein the applicant must: affirm an affinity to and interest in Italian culture and swear to abide by the By-laws and rules of the Roma Lodge and a commitment to become an active member of the Roma Lodge.
- They would need to be proposed to become a member by a current general member, and they will not have the ability to sponsor or propose new members of the Lodge.

This proposed amendment will be discussed at our upcoming August general membership meeting, and the membership present at the September general membership meeting will vote on whether

the proposed amendment should be adopted into the By-laws of the Lodge.

**Remember that to be passed, amendments to our By-laws must be passed by a 2/3rds majority vote of the members present at a regular meeting of the general membership that meets the requirement of a quorum.






