

We would love to see you at our next show on Sunday, December 18th from 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM!



BEFORE THE BEGINNING

In the year 1907, the citizenry of Italian descent of Racine, Wisconsin formed and belonged to seven societies and clubs. They were:

Societa Italiana di Mutuo Soccorso

Clobo Cæsari Battista

Unioni Fratelli Calabrese di Mutuo Soccorso

Societa Fratelli Bantieri

Societa di San Michele

Societa di San Vincenzo

Societa di Santa Lucia


With all of these organizations, frequently some of these members belonged to as many as five societies at one time. There are three surviving today who were charter members. They are Brothers Nicola DeMark, Frank Litrenta and John Litrenta.

THE BEGINNING

On February 23, 1923, approximately 125 persons from the aforementioned clubs applied for a charter to the Order of Sons of Italy in America.

This Order, then under the leadership of Supreme Venerable Ralph Ruffoni, was founded in New York in 1905, as a national organization with subsidiaries throughout the United States and Canada
