1923 - 2023



Rick Bonanno was given a booklet on the Grand Opening of our clubhouse on Forest Street (Memorial Drive) by the UW-Parkside Historical Society. Our member, Robert Vallone helped by digitizing the booklet. In addition to the stories submitted by members we will include pages from this booklet.

I am happy to share additional pages from the booklet in this newsletter. I hope this will prompt our members to submit more stories.





Ever since Columbus discovered America, the Italians have shared in our history development and progress. They are an integral part of our country. The Italians in America have helped to create our national wealth, in fact, at one period of our history they were our economic salvation. The Italian immigrants, for the most part of the peasant class, who left their native land for the past sixty years in the hope of improving their economic condition have come to these shores with a great faith in their hearts for the land of promise. They have been treated with every indifference and only in a haphazard way have they been permitted to come in contact with the brightest side of American life. They have been excluded from American social and religious life as undesirable and given scant opportunities to learn English in casual night schools only after brain deadening days of toil. Is it any wonder that they are slow, with their Latin tongue, in learning a strange language, and in becoming Americanized as rapidly as immigrants of other nationalities, who may have the advantage of the English language to start with? Yet in spite of racial prejudice and discrimination, the Italian immigrants with their inborn fortitude, have risen superior to every obstacle.

No statistics whatever are available on the number of Italian-Americans in the service of the United States during the First World War, but quoting no less authority than the Chairman of the Committee on Public Information during the war, Mr. Geo. R. Creel, in Everybody's Magazine of March 1919: "The Italians in the United States are not more than 4% of the whole population, but the list of casualties show a full 10% of Italian names. More than 300,000 Italian-Americans figured in the Army lists, and in defense of the inner lines as well as on the firing lines they proved their patriotism to the country of their adoption." There was no ship yard, ammunition factory, airplane factory, steel mill, mine, lumber camp or dock in which the Italian did not play a large part, and often the most prominent part, working at all times with full and affectionate loyalty for the government of the United States. And, in the recent World War, the record of more than a million young Americans of Italian ancestry, speaks for itself. Typical of these young men, are Captain Gentile who distinguished himself in the Army Air Force, and Gunnery Sgt. John Basilone, a hero of Guadalcanal, and the first en'isted Marine to win the Congressional Medal of Honor in World War II.
