Thirty Ninth Annual Bocce Invitational Tournament Sunday, August 14, 2022

Bocce Rules

1. Each team will consist of four (4) players plus an alternate if so desired in both the open/men's tournament as well as the women's tournament:

WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 5 TEAMS REGISTERED PRIOR TO SUNDAY, AUGUST 7 OR IT WILL BE CANCELLED. TEAMS WILL BE GIVEN THE OPTION TO REGISTER FOR THE OPEN TOURNAMENT.

- 2. If the pallino goes out of bounds, it will be placed on the nail. If the large ball goes out of bounds, it is considered a dead ball. All bocce balls including the pallino must cross the center line to be in play.
- 3. A team must have four (4) players to start a game (2 players on one end and 2 on the other end throw 2 balls each). A team has 10 minutes from the time the ref calls for the game to begin to have an eligible team. Once a player begins a game and is substituted for, he/she may not re-enter the same game. Once a player begins a game on a certain side, he/she must remain on that side the entire game, unless substituted for.
- 4. Referee will handle all games. The Bocce Committee will decide major disputes

On behalf of the Roma Lodge and its members, we would like to invite you to this year's Roma Lodge Bocce Tournament. We hope that you will be able to participate in this exciting event which not only allows everyone to play the wonderful game of bocce, but also presents a festival atmosphere with all the great people who join us.

Again, this year's tournament will be Round Robin Style. This means that all teams will be playing a minimum of 3 (possibly 4) games. All games will be played up to between 9 and 12 points, depending on the number of entries. Once group play is completed, those teams advancing will play in a single elimination tournament. The quarter-finals, semi-finals, and finals will all be played up to 16 points.

This year, we will once again have Roma Lodge's famous food, including pane fritta (fried bread dough) made by Lisa Domanico, Joan Domanico, Rosemarie Domanico and their entire crew of amazing women from the Vittoria Colonna Lodge! Kringle, bombers, tomato salad, corn on the cob, and Roma Lodge's famous buffet dinner featuring Lasagna and our popular Italian baked chicken will be available for your enjoyment! Tap beer and soda will be included from 10:30-3:30. A minimum of \$5,400.00 in cash prizes is expected to be awarded between the open, and the women's tournament based on 39 men's teams and 16 women's teams.

For those of you who come from Illinois and the Milwaukee, Kenosha, and Madison area, we once again look forward to sharing our club with all of you. The great thing about our tournament is that we have been fortunate to have good teams come play, but we also have many teams who just love to play bocce...enjoying the food and camaraderie equally as much. Please remember to get your team entry in as early as possible to ensure your team's spot. We hope to make this not only another exciting day as bocce players, but a day that brings Italians together from all over! Hope to see you once again August 14!
