
ROMA LODGE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION 1923 - 2023

As part of our celebration and to bring awareness to our storied history we will be running articles and stories throughout the year celebrating our history.



Two Roma Lodge Members were recently recognized as 2023 Horlick High School Graduates of Distinction.

Graduate of Distinction Martin Defatte - Class of 1961

Following his graduation as a member of Horlick's class of 1961, Marty started his career in the United States Army as a Military Police Officer. Upon his return to Racine, Marty joined the Racine Police Department in 1965 and dedicated 30 years of his life to serving the city of Racine in various roles, including Community Relations Officer, Hostage Negotiation Team member, and 1-Person Crime Prevention Unit. Throughout his time on the force, Marty remained committed to making a positive impact on the community. He established a youth drop-in center on Main Street in 1971, providing guidance and mentoring to young people.

In 1974, he championed the need for a community shelter for abused women, which led to the creation of the Women's Resource Center. As Racine's first Community Oriented Police Officer (COP) he worked to build relationships and solve problems at the community level, resulting in reduced crime rates. In recognition of his dedication and contributions, the 6th Street COP house was named after him in 2019.

Marty has been a member of several community organizations, including the '61 Horlick Class Reunion Committee, Racine Community Outpost, Roma Lodge, Racine Veteran Village, Racine Rising Stars, and Hispanic Business Professionals Association. He has received numerous awards for his outstanding service, including the Exemplary Officer Award in 1994, Crime Prevention Officer of the Year, Outstanding Officer of the Year, Good Neighbor Award from the Volunteer Center of Racine in 2014, and Community Enhancement Award from the Hispanic Business Professional Association in 2017. He was also honored with the Racine Jaycees Meritorious Service Award in 1969 and the Racine Jaycees Outstanding Young Law Officer Award in 1972.

Marty is a dedicated volunteer who is devoted to serving his community. He has contributed to numerous projects, such as being a Kids Cove Building Volunteer and a Building Volunteer at Franksville Park. In 2013, Marty and Donna traveled to Tanzania to build homes in local villages, and just recently in July 2022, he traveled to Armenia with the Fuller Center for Housing to help construct homes. He also volunteers his truck and time to support the Kiwanis Holiday Lights Display and has provided valuable guidance and recommendations for the Friday Concert Series on Monument Square, donating chairs for the event as well. Additionally, he continues to volunteer his time and truck to various community organizations. Marty has not slowed down since graduating from Horlick, in addition to volunteering he is currently a real estate agent with Shorewest Reality.

Marty's love for his hometown of Racine is second only to his love for his family. He and his wife, Donna, have been happily married for 61 years, having been high school sweethearts. Marty's devotion to his community and family is evident through his accomplishments and service. Nevertheless, he acknowledges that his achievements would not have been possible without the unwavering support of his wife, Donna. Marty is a true family man, committed to being a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He is a selfless and faithful individual who is always willing to lend a helping hand to his loved ones and community. Marty's family takes great pride in his compassionate nature and the positive influence he has had on the community of Racine. While his three grandchildren may boast about the time, he lassoed an alligator that escaped from the zoo, what they admire most is his unwavering commitment to doing what is right and selflessly helping others.

Bocce Rules

- 1. Each team will consist of four (4) players plus an alternate if so desired in both the open/men's tournament as well as the women's tournament:
- 2. If the pallino goes out of bounds, it will be placed on the nail. If the large ball goes out of bounds, it is considered a dead ball. The pallino must cross the center line to be in play, a player's ball does not.
- 3. A team must have four (4) players to start a game (2 players on one end and 2 on the other end throw 2 balls each). A team has 10 minutes from the time the ref calls for the game to begin to have an eligible team. Once a player begins a game and is substituted for, he/she may not re-enter the same game. Once a player begins a game on a certain side, he/she must remain on that side the entire game, unless substituted for.
- 4. The referee will handle all games. The Bocce Committee will decide major disputes.

On behalf of the Roma Lodge and its members, we would like to invite you to this year's Roma Lodge Bocce Tournament. I hope that you will be able to participate in this exciting event which not only allows everyone to play the wonderful game of bocce, but also presents a festival atmosphere with all the great people who join us.

Again, this year's tournament will be Round Robin Style. This means that all teams will be playing a minimum of 3 (possibly 4) games. All games will be played up to between 10 and 12 points, depending on the number of entries. Once group play is completed, those teams advancing will play in a single elimination tournament. The finals will all be played up to 16 points.

This year, we will once again have Roma Lodge's famous food, including pane fritta (fried bread dough) made by Lisa Domanico, Joan Domanico, Rosemarie Domanico, and their entire crew of amazing women from the Vittoria Colonna Lodge! Kringle, bombers, tomato salad, corn on the cob, and Roma Lodge's famous buffet dinner featuring Stuffed Shells and our popular Italian baked chicken! Tap beer and soda will be included from 10:30-3:30. Cash prizes will be awarded to at least the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places.
