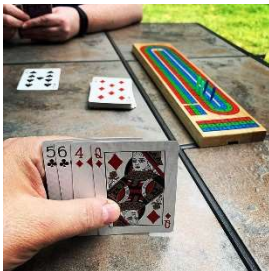

### Peno Bilello Biography

Fellow member Nick Bilello shared a story about his father, a member and one of the past presidents of the lodge.

Peno joined Roma Lodge in 1965 at age 50. He served in the Army Corps of Engineers from 1943 to 1944, attending boot camp at Fort Leonard Wood, and was certified as a sharpshooter. Peno's specialty was building bridges. He also drove a supply truck for KP duty and took leftovers to a farmer for his pigs. The farmer's wife washed his clothes and gave him soap to bathe with, making him the best smelling soldier in his group.

Peno Bilello served RIWA as a board member and was president for four years.

Peno's work history included working at Pugh Coal Co unloading coal ships in Racine. He later worked at Wisconsin Natural Gas Co. in the display department constructing retail store displays at stores throughout SE Wisconsin. Peno also used his skills with sign painting and cabinet making, some of which can be found at Roma Lodge. Peno worked at Roma Festival on Memorial Drive making pizza and Italian bombers. Later Peno served on the new Roma Lodge Building Committee for over a year. Peno volunteered at Bingo night making popcorn and worked for the Roma Festival at the lakefront and was the first to place Italian Flags on the Festival Hall roof. Peno enjoyed spending time with his family especially in the Members Restaurant. Peno served as building maintenance supervisor. Peno was a proud Roma Lodge member for over twenty-nine years until his passing in 1996.

Rawley, who compiled a 12-9 record in 1984 with the New York Yankees and Phillies, will be made an honorary member of the Roma Lodge.

He joins a list of former Athletes of the Year which includes Vince Lombardi and Bart Starr.

Cocktails are planned for 6:30 p.m., with dinner at 7:30 p.m. and the ceremony honoring Rawley immediately following.

Several speakers will honor Rawley, including his parents, Bill and Pat Rawley; former Horlick baseball coach George Tigges; Montreal Expos assistant minor league scouting director Pat Daugherty, and G. Edward Frier, a Sarasota, Fla., neighbor of Rawley's.

Daugherty was Rawley's coach at Indian Hills Community College in Centerville, Iowa. Daugherty also coached Duane Kuiper and Eric Rasmussen, two other Racine baseball players who made it to the major leagues.
