The Roma Lodge Board of Directors sent out an email update last week to our members regarding the Lodge. In case you missed it, here it is:

The Roma Lodge Board of Directors would like to provide you with an update on measures that have been taken regarding the RIWA and the Lodge. The Board of Directors has been in regular contact via email, phone calls, and a conference call which will continue every few weeks until the ban of groups of 10 or more is lifted.

The RIWA staff has called and suspended/delayed vendor services that are not needed while we are unable to hold events. These include Aramark (uniforms), Bay Towel (linens), Eagle (dumpster pick-up will be once a month), Lakeshore (snow/grass), etc. All staff that is not needed has been laid off, and we can't express how understanding they all have been.

Events were re-scheduled for a future date with great cooperation including multiple weddings; no refunds of deposits have been requested. Briana is working in the office during the day answering phones and continues to meet with perspective future clients. The carryout/curbside service has been profitable on available evenings to date and seems to be growing in popularity. We thank all the members who have placed orders and supported the club during this difficult time.

The Roma Lodge Members' Restaurant and Bar will remain closed until it is safe to reopen. Honor bar, pizza, bocce, are still available to any member, but we ask that you obey the group ban of 10 as well as practice social distancing. The April membership meeting is cancelled. Pancake Day has been postponed and Bingo is suspended. All member events that were scheduled are either cancelled or postponed until further notice.

Again, please continue to keep your families safe as we all look forward to returning to our normal lives in the future.
