## AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS - RESULTS

These proposed amendments were voted on at the September Members Meeting. The first proposed by-law change, to move the members' meeting night to the first Friday of the month, did not pass. The second by-law change to shorten the time to membership did pass.

Newly enacted by-law change to Par E. and F.:

- E. Following: 1) the Membership Committee's review of the application and any additional materials pertinent to the application; 2) completion of its interview of the applicant, and; 3) delivery of its recommendation to the Board of Directors, the Board of Directors will make a determination as to whether the applicant should be deemed acceptable to become a member of the Lodge. If the Board of Directors determines that the applicant is acceptable for membership, the name of the applicant and his sponsor must appear on the Roma Lodge website under the Membership Section and be published in the monthly newsletter so that the general membership will have notice of the proposed new member. This will also give the membership an opportunity to advise the Membership Chairman if there is reason for disapproval of the applicant prior to a vote on admission

of the applicant as a member at the next members' meeting.

- F. If either a member of the Board or the General Membership has questions or concerns regarding the applicant that cannot be resolved in a timely manner, the applicant and his proponent must meet with the Membership Committee to address any issues of concern. In this case, a final decision on the applicant will be postponed until the Board of Directors has determined that any concerns have been resolved to its satisfaction."

(This amendment will shorten the amount of time between when the Board of Directors makes a determination that an applicant should be deemed acceptable to become a member of the Lodge, and when the general membership may take a vote on whether the applicant should become a probational member of the lodge.)

These proposed amendments were discussed at our August General Membership Meeting, and the membership present at the September general members' meeting will vote on whether either, both or none of the proposed amendments will be adopted into the By-laws of the Lodge.

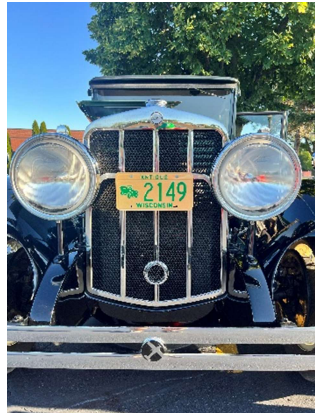
